Designing your research is an intensive two-day seminar wherein the main pillars of the research are reviewed, their consistencies are checked. The seminar exposes the aim and roles of the main phases of the thesis' text: research question and problematization, quality criteria/argumentation strategy, literature review, choice of method (be it quantitative or qualitative), data interpretation, researcher's position and writing, and each participant works on her or his own project, individually and collectively.

This seminar is especially useful at the following stage:

- Review of the whole project before the final writing
- Reflection on the project after the first year, and before presenting it in front of the thesis committee.
- Moments when the researcher feels s/he may reorient the project

Course language is English. Reflexivity rather than recipe will be emphasized.
